1. Friday 11th October 2.30 – 3.30pm

Classroom Session. Children spend time in a Prep classroom with help from our wonderful Grade 6 leaders. Parents have the opportunity to participate in an informative session with our Principal Mat Anderton, the Business Manager Lori Lundberg and SPARTANS (our uniform supplier) in the Library.

Specialist Session. Children rotate between two of our wonderful specialists (Music & PE or Art & STEAM), the Prep teachers will accompany them. Parents have the opportunity to participate in an information session with our Principal Mat Anderton and Occupational Therapist Michelle Moya in the Library.

Specialist Session. Children spend time with the other two brilliant specialists (again, with the Prep teachers). Parents have the opportunity to participate in an information session with our Speech Pathologist Mel Hedstrom and our Out of Hours Care providers OSHClub in the Library.

4. Tuesday 10th December. 9.30-10.30am

Meet the Teacher. Children continue to build their confidence within their 2025 classroom, getting to know their teacher and making new friends as they learn and play. Parents will participate in a short informative session with SMILE Club (in school dentist service) and a representative from our Community Hub and indulge in a delicious morning tea in the Library.

Our Transition sessions offer children a broad experience of our school and the people they will get to know next year. This structure helps children to feel supported and confident about coming to school. We do understand that not all children can attend all of our transition sessions. In these circumstances we recommend that children attend the last three sessions when children spend time with the specialists and in their new classroom with their Prep teacher.
