

Egg Drop Challenge 2023

National Science Week is coming up and what better way to celebrate it than attempting a STEAM challenge at home!

The Challenge

• To build a structure that will prevent an egg from cracking when dropped from a high place.

Allowed Materials

• Anything that can be cut by scissors.

Restrictions

- Structure must be no bigger than a shoe box
- Structure must be built (no premade boxes)
- Drop must be done on concrete
- Drop must be measured for height and filmed

Tips and Ideas

- Brainstorm and draw a design of your structure before building
- Measure the height before dropping
- Ask your parents for the best place to test the concrete drops!
