Exploring, Playing, and Creating Together!

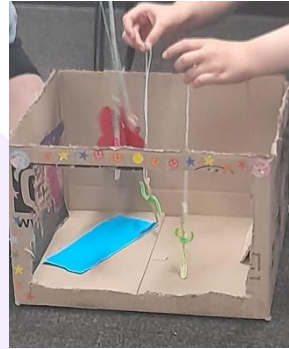

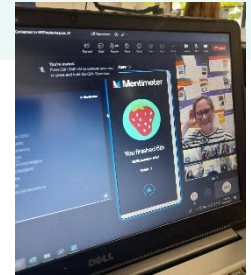
